## 01 Start with the Colour Story

Before changing anything, look at the colours already living in your room.

|   |                                                            |
|---|------------------------------------------------------------|
| ■ | Do I have 2–3 main colours in this room?                   |
| ■ | Do my soft furnishings relate to those colours?            |
| ■ | Is one colour repeated enough to create visual connection? |

### QUICK INSIGHT

**A room doesn't always need more colour. It often needs better colour connection.**

## 02 Add Texture, Not Just More Things

Look beyond colour. Texture is what gives a room depth and warmth.

|---|--------------------------------------------------------------|
| ■ | Do I have more than one visible texture?                     |
| ■ | Do I have a mix of smooth, soft, woven or textured surfaces? |
| ■ | Does anything look too flat or visually repetitive?          |

### QUICK INSIGHT

**Smooth + soft + woven + textured can feel richer than four elements that look the same.**

### 03 Give the Sofa a Supporting Cast

Your sofa is one of the largest visual elements in the living room.

|---|-------------------------------------------------------------------|
| ■ | Do my cushions connect with the room's colour story?              |
| ■ | Do different cushion sizes, patterns and textures create balance? |
| ■ | Does the sofa feel finished rather than slightly empty?           |

#### QUICK INSIGHT

**Sometimes the sofa isn't the problem — the relationship between the sofa and surrounding elements is.**

### 04 Check the Windows

Curtains can quietly influence the entire feeling of a room.

|---|----------------------------------------------------------------|
| ■ | Do my curtains support the overall colour story?               |
| ■ | Do they add softness and warmth?                               |
| ■ | Do they complement the furniture instead of competing with it? |

### 05 Take the One-Glance Test

Stand at the entrance and look at the room for five seconds.

#### QUICK INSIGHT

**Where do your eyes go first — and where do they go next? If your eye jumps randomly, the room may need better visual connection.**
