A practical guide to making smarter décor decisions — before buying anything new.

Because sometimes the problem isn't that your room needs something new. It needs something different.

1 What problem am I trying to solve?

Too plain? Too cold? Disconnected? Too busy? Missing colour, texture or warmth?

QUICK INSIGHT

Don't buy until you can name the problem.

2 What do I already have?

Photograph the room and identify the furniture, colours, patterns, textures and accessories already present.

QUICK INSIGHT

You may discover you already have enough pieces — they simply aren't visually connected.

3 Does the new piece have a relationship with something already there?

Ask: "What exactly will this new element connect with?"

QUICK INSIGHT

Good décor doesn't exist alone.

4

Am I matching — or coordinating?

Matching makes things look similar. Coordinating makes things feel connected without making them identical.

QUICK INSIGHT

The goal is connection, not repetition.

Am I adding another pattern?

Look at the patterns already in the room. Is the room missing pattern — or missing balance?

QUICK INSIGHT

Sometimes adding another pattern makes a room feel more confused.

6

What happens if I remove something instead?

Take one decorative element away. Step back. Look again.

QUICK INSIGHT

Editing can create more impact than adding.

7

Will I still love this choice six months from now?

Don't choose something only because it is trending or looked beautiful in someone else's home.

QUICK INSIGHT

The best question is: "Does this belong in MY home?"

THE 3-QUESTION RULE

Before making your next décor decision, ask:

■	Does it solve a problem?
■	Does it connect with something I already own?
■	Does it belong to the feeling I want my home to create?

QUICK INSIGHT

If the answer is YES to all three, you're probably making a thoughtful choice. If not — pause before purchasing.
